Driver for Hire Online Training is a collaborative venture introduced by the Canada Safety Council in partnership with Bluedrop ISM, and funded by the Government of Canada's Skills for Success Program.

The online training advances job-specific and essential skills for paid professional drivers in any sector, including rideshare, taxi, delivery, and courier. The course includes 8 impactful modules, is available in **5** languages, and can be completed at the student's desired pace.

The following insights were obtained from an online survey of over **5,800** individuals during the no-cost pilot phase.




